

Computer on network cannot "see" any other machines in My Network Places or Computer on network has "lost" its F, G, H, drive

First, check the cable which connects the computer to the network is plugged in. Then shut down and restart, when the machine asks for a name and password type in your user name (and password if you have one) then click **OK**.

Probably someone has started it up when the server (the other machine on the network represented by the F,G,H,.. drive) was switched off. First, try closing down and re-starting the computer and make sure you follow your normal login procedure if you have one.

If that doesn't work, double-click on **Network Neighbourhood**, or **My Network Places**, double-click on name of server, right click on the shared drive on the server, left click on **Map Network Drive**. Choose appropriate drive letter, tick box which says "reconnect at logon."
